

Commissioner's Virtual Listening Tour

The Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) announced that Commissioner of Education and Chief Learner Jason E. Glass will be conducting a virtual listening tour April 6-May 6 to gather input on long-term aspirations for the Commonwealth's education system.

Nine sessions will be held across the state April 6-May 6, one in coordination with each cooperative region and one in Louisville. The sessions will be in the evening and will last approximately 90 minutes and feature breakout rooms facilitated by Kentucky high school students and Team KDE staff. The questions will be focused on several key areas – teaching, learning, engagement, mental health, testing, equity, civics and career and technical education.
