The Indiana Department of Health is currently seeking an **Early Intervention Specialist** within the Center for Deaf and Hard of Hearing Education. This position will provide early intervention home visiting as a Family Navigator and mentoring other providers as part of the Early Intervention program within the Center.

This is a unique opportunity to reach families of deaf and hard of hearing infants and toddlers, supporting their connection to information and resources. In addition, this position provides training, mentoring and support to contract providers within the Center's early intervention program. Early Intervention Specialists at the Center also create resources for families and professionals in the early intervention system.

Through service provision and dissemination of resources and information, this position will assist the Center with the mission: *To promote positive outcomes for all deaf and hard of hearing children through information, services and education.* The Center is seeking professionals who hold a degree in Deaf Education, Speech-Language Pathology, Audiology or a related field and hold or has the ability to obtain credentialing as a First Steps provider. Additionally, candidates should possess the ability to establish priorities, meet deadlines, and manage a variety of tasks related to the mission of the Center.
