Landline Phones

ATTACH A COPY OF YOUR PHONE BILL!

A **copy** of the section of your phone bill that has your name, address and phone number is **required** and **must be included** with your application. If your name is not on your bill, then you **must attach** a copy of a driver's license or other official documentation/ID showing proof that you live at the address you wrote on the application.
