

Locating Sign Language Classes

There are many sign language classes being offered throughout the country. Unfortunately it is not possible to keep up-to-date records of all locations. These are some of the places most likely either to offer classes or to have information about them.

- → Religious Affiliated Organizations
- → State Schools for Deaf Children
- → Interpreters for deaf people
- → Deafness-Related Organizations/Groups
- + State Offices/Commissions for Deaf and Hard of Hearing people
